Art	<p>Independent learning is project based. Students will be expected to do at least one hour per fortnight. Tasks will include: drawings, collages, research.</p> <p>Each year group at Key Stage 3 will also have one independent research task to complete during the year.</p>	Fortnightly
Citizenship	<p>Year 7 students have one Citizenship project to complete after Easter. They have 6 weeks to complete it and should spend a minimum of one hour per week on the project.</p> <p>Year 8 students have two research tasks to complete, one before Christmas and one after Easter. They have 6 weeks to complete their projects and should spend a minimum of one hour per week on the project.</p> <p>Year 9 students have two research tasks to complete, one after October half term and one after May half term. They have 6 weeks to complete their project and should spend a minimum of one hour per week on the project.</p>	Termly
Drama	<p>Students can find their homework on the MLE in the Autumn and Spring terms. Homework comprises learning a part from a short play.</p>	Termly
English	<p>Students are given spelling lists to learn; a WOW (Word of the Week) to learn; 20 minutes of Accelerated Reader per day and Accelerated Reader quizzes to complete on line when applicable.</p>	Weekly

All independent learning must be submitted as a paper copy. ICT	There are three possible pieces of independent learning from each Scheme of Work which students will complete. These include investigating databases, planning a presentation, looking at the use of spread sheets outside of school, or anti bullying campaign.	Fortnightly
Maths	Students will be expected to complete a 30 minute exercise either using mymaths or work will be set on Show My Homework.	Weekly
MFL	Students will be set vocabulary to learn and be given reading and writing exercises to complete from their MFL book. Approximately every eight weeks, students will be given revision to prepare for their end of unit assessments. Year 8 students will be given French and German homework once per fortnight.	Weekly
Music	Students will receive theory work based around worksheets that reinforce learning carried out in the lesson as well as practical work which allows students to take home keyboard/vocal/instrumental worksheets to work on in their own times. In Year 8, all students study a unit of work based on Mozart. The homework during this unit is based around developing their literacy skills.	Fortnightly
RS	Students will receive one piece of project based work. This will be set within the first two weeks of the half term and be due in by the end.	One per half term.
Science	Students will be set a variety of independent learning activities linked to the topic they are studying. These will include research projects, literacy based activities and APP tasks.	Fortnightly
