Year 9 students have two research tasks to complete, one after October half term and one after May half term. ICT	There are three possible pieces of independent learning from each Scheme of Work which students will complete. These include investigating databases, planning a presentation, looking at the use of spread sheets outside of school, or anti bullying campaign.	Fortnightly
History	Students will complete topic projects. They will be given to students at the start of each topic and will need to be submitted at the end of the half term.	Once per half term

Students have between two and three weeks to complete independent learning and are given clear instructions and level descriptors. All independent learning must be submitted as a paper copy.
