Dear parent/carers

The end of term experience days are fast approaching and we hope that your child is excited about their day at the Southbank, London. To ensure that every student and staff member has an enjoyable day can you please ensure that you and your child are familiar with the arrangements for the day.

- Time of arrival to school 8.00am 13th July 2023.
- Students to report to English 8**
- Departure to London 9.30am
- (All students and staff will be walking to Legrave train station and catching the first available train after 9.30am)**
- Departure from London 4.30pm
 - We are expected to return to school for 6.00pm 13th July 2023.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch for the day or have enough money for the purchasing of food whilst in London (maximum £25 cash). Any students entitled to a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch for the day.

All students are required to bring enough liquids to last them for the length of the experience day. Students will also need to bring additional money if they wish to use any of the numerous attractions found on the Southbank.

Students are required to wear sensible footwear and clothing for the day. Please check the weather for the day, and ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the expected weather conditions. This will include sun protection (Minimum of SPF30) and a rain jacket if needed.

All students must stay with their designated staff member throughout the day, however, students will have the opportunity to plan their day of activities and sites they see. Students must ensure that they exhibit the school's values of respect, responsibility and excellence throughout the experience day and stay within the areas explained to them on the day.
