Dear Parent / Carer,

We are writing to you to inform you about an upcoming event at school. As part of the year 10 Aspire Curriculum, we are organising a 'Lealands' Got Talent' competition. The aim of the competition is to give students the opportunity to showcase their performance skills and to raise money for Comic Relief in March 2023.

The competition will be held at school on Friday 3rd March 2023. The competition will begin at 1:30pm and will finish at 3pm.

Your child has had the opportunity to choose to apply to be a performer. Due to the time constraints, there will only be ten places available for performances. Students can perform on their own or as part of a team (maximum 10 students per team). If there are more than ten acts that apply to perform, the names of the acts that are able to perform on the day will be drawn from a hat. If your child wishes to participate as a performer, the deadline for this application to be completed will be Friday 24th February 2023. Information on how to apply to perform was explained in your child's assembly the week beginning 6th February 2023.

If your child does not want to participate as a performer, but would like to support the event, they have the option to become a member of the audience. A ticket to become a member of the audience will be on sale from Monday 20th February 2023 to 27th February 2023. The cost of a ticket will be £1. However, if you are willing and able to donate any more money towards the event, this would increase the amount of money that we raise for charity and would be greatly appreciated.

Tickets can be purchased via the school online payment system, Scopay. Please scroll to the Trips and Events section and select '2023 Lealands Got Talent 03/03/23 Ticket'. You will then have the option to either donate £1 or add your own amount (over £1). If your child would rather pay in person using cash, a stall will be available at break time on Thursday 23rd and Friday 24th February in the Main Corridor. Due to the capacity of the Main Hall, the number of tickets available is restricted to 170 tickets.
