After marking is finished, students will receive their marks, grades and detailed feedback during a lesson. This approach ensures that feedback is purposeful, clearly explained, and helps students understand how to improve ahead of their final examinations.

During these lessons, exam papers may be used to support feedback. However, in line with examination board (JCQ) regulations:

- Exam papers must not be written on
- Exam papers cannot be taken home


Following the feedback lesson, all exam papers are collected and stored securely within school.
