Relationship & Sex Education

Your child's Religion and Society curriculum will include the Relationship & Sex Education that is relevant to them this academic year.

Relationship & Sex Education is an important part of a young person's education and our aim is to provide students with factual information and enable them to make healthy informed choices as they move into adult life. We aim to increase knowledge, change attitudes and enhance skills, in order to positively impact young people's behaviour.

These lessons are taught by teachers within our humanities department who have been provided with specialist training in the subject. Some topics within the curriculum will be taught in single sex groups, where it is felt this is appropriate.

The schedule we will be following is shown below:
