Subject: Year 11 Intervention Attendance – Important Update

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to follow up on your child's attendance at Year 11 intervention sessions.

As part of our ongoing work to support students in achieving their best possible outcomes in their GCSE examinations, we closely monitor **attendance to intervention and additional support sessions**. These sessions are targeted, subject-specific, and designed to address key gaps identified through assessments and mock examinations.

Our recent review shows **attendance to intervention has been inconsistent**, which is a concern at this crucial stage of Year 11. Regular attendance is essential if students are to make the progress needed between now and the summer examinations.

To support you and your child:

- We have re-sent the current Year 11 intervention timetable with this email.
- Students are expected to attend all sessions they have been allocated unless there is a genuine reason for absence.

We ask for your support in:

- Ensuring your child attends all allocated intervention sessions.
- Discussing the importance of these sessions with your child.
- Contacting the school if there are any barriers preventing attendance, so we can work together to support them.


