Dear Parent/Carer.

We are delighted to be able to offer your child the opportunity to attend a trip to Blue Peris Mountain Centre in North Wales from Sunday 19th to Friday 24th November 2023.

Your child will develop their leadership skills, communication, team work and social skills whilst learning how to overcome their fears in a challenging outdoor environment. They will experience activities such as gorge walking, sea level traversing, mining, rock climbing and abseiling. They will also experience the thrill and wonderful sense of achievement when they climb a real mountain! We believe that the Blue Peris trip will give your child the priceless opportunity to experience a world full of natural challenges, both physical and mental, but very far removed from what has become the norm in modern society. With this in mind, we do not allow students to take mobile phones, games consoles or any other electrical devices on this trip. We believe that these measures will allow your child to get the very most from this fantastic experience. An assembly introducing your child to the trip will take place on Wednesday 25th January.

The cost of the trip will be £394.00 - £444.00 depending on final numbers. Once we have received everyone's £50 deposit, a further letter will be sent out explaining the final cost and detailing the payment plan. The non- refundable £50 deposit must be paid to the Finance Department by Wednesday 1st March 2023.

Payment can be made by cheque payable to Lealands High School or online using the link from our school website. Log on details have been supplied but if you require these again, please contact the Finance Department. The cost of the trip includes all transport, meals and activities undertaken during the trip. The only item you will need to buy for the trip is one pair of walking socks; everything else you will need is supplied by the centre.

The school reserves the right to refuse this opportunity if a student's conduct is deemed inappropriate for this visit at any time between now and the trip.

This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to experience a number of outdoor education activities in a safe and secure environment, under the supervision of highly trained and qualified staff. A reply slip for the trip can be collected by your child from Mr Purdy. Please complete the reply slip if you would like your child to attend the trip. We need a minimum of 20 students for the trip to take place but can take up to 40 students if needed.
