Dear Parent/Carer,

As we look forward to the end of term and the forthcoming Summer School, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for all your support and engagement with the school. It has been another fantastic year where we continue to be delighted with our students' work ethic, especially those showcased at our Evenings of Excellence over the last term.

I would like to confirm that on Friday 18th July 2025, school will finish for the end of term at 12:20pm for students in Years 7 and 8 and 12:30pm for students in Year 9 and 10. Students will leave school by their usual exits.

If you require supervision for your son/daughter until the usual end of the school day, please contact the appropriate Head of Year or Pastoral Support Manager, who will be able to arrange this.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch will be available for them to collect at break time.

Students will be expected to go straight home and must, on no account, visit local primary schools.

Students should continue to attend school in full school uniform/PE kit (where Lealands PE kit is an option until further notice) on all days up to and including Friday 18th July, except for Cultural Heritage Day, Experience Day and Sports Days (PE kit for Sports Day)). Thank you for your support in helping us to maintain our high expectations.

For Experience Day (Thursday 10th July) students attending trips should wear appropriate clothing in-line with the communication received for the trip they are attending. Students attending school on that day must be either in full school uniform or Lealands PE kit.

For Sports Day students should be in their full Lealands PE kit:-

- Monday 7th July Year 9
- Tuesday 8th July Year 10
- Wednesday 9th July Year 7
- Friday 11th July Year 8

For Cultural Heritage Day (Tuesday 15th July) students can wear cultural dress, a plain red T-Shirt in support of anti-racism or an international football shirt. If wearing a T-shirt or football shirt, this should be with school trousers/skirt and shoes. Students choosing not to dress for Cultural Heritage Day should wear full school uniform or PE kit.

Students will continue to be collected by staff from line ups for their first lesson and after social times as this has supported calm and orderly transitions into school and lessons with these being well supervised and managed by staff.
