Students to report to the astroturf pitch

- Departure to Chessington 8.15am
(The coach will depart promptly at 8.15am to maximise the time at the experience)
- Departure from Chessington 5.30pm
- We expected to return to school for 7.15pm 13th July 2023.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch for the day or have enough money for the purchasing of food at the experience (no more than £15 cash). Any students entitled to a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch for the day.

All students are required to bring enough liquids to last them for the length of the experience day.

Students are required to wear sensible footwear and clothing for the day. Please check the weather for the day, and ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the expected weather conditions. This will include sun protection (minimum of SPF30) and a rain jacket if needed.

All students must stay in groups of 4 (minimum group size) throughout the day and check in with the staff attending at the specified times and meeting points. Students must ensure that they exhibit the school's values of respect, responsibility and excellence throughout the experience day.
