Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to inform you that our school has been mentioned in recent social media posts linked to a trend sometimes referred to as “Red vs Blue School Wars.”

These posts, which have been circulating on platforms such as TikTok and Snapchat, suggest potential gatherings or confrontations between groups of young people from different schools. At this stage, we have no evidence to indicate that any specific incident is planned. However, we are taking this matter seriously and are working closely with local partners to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our pupils. **Actions We Are Taking**

We are:

- Working with local police and neighbouring schools
- Monitoring the situation carefully
- Speaking with pupils about how to stay safe
- Increasing staff presence at the start and end of the school day where necessary
- Reminding pupils about safe behaviour online and in the community

How You Can Help

We ask that you:

- Talk with your child about these posts and discourage any involvement
- Remind them not to attend any gatherings arranged through social media
- Encourage safe, direct travel to and from school
- Remind them to report any worrying messages to a trusted adult

Please reassure your child that many of these social media posts are designed to cause alarm or attract attention. Pupils should not respond to or share these messages.

Reporting Concerns

If your child has seen messages that concern them, please contact the school so that we can respond appropriately.

If you believe there is an immediate risk to safety, please contact the police on 101, or 999 in an emergency.

The safety and wellbeing of our pupils remains our highest priority. Thank you for your continued support in helping us keep all pupils safe.
