Dear Parent/Carer,

We are coming toward the end of the self-isolation period for Year 7 students. I am sorry that this had to take place, but you will understand, I am sure, that there is the potential for this to happen from time to time. It has been the experience of most schools nationally that some groups of students are being required to be sent home following identification of positive Covid-19 cases in schools.

The likelihood of this can be reduced if all parents are extremely cautious not to send their child to school if they suspect they have Covid-19 symptoms, anyone in their household does or they have been in close contact with someone who tests positive or displays the symptoms.

We hope that there will not be further incidents of bubbles/groups of students being required to isolate and will do all we can in school to try to prevent this, but realistically, it is possible during the year.

In light of this, we would really like to seek your feedback on the online Google Classroom learning your child has been engaged in during the isolation period. Any feedback will be highly valuable as we refine our systems and approaches to do this as well as possible. I would greatly appreciate it if you could complete the survey available by clicking the link at the bottom of this letter.

I am aware that a small group of students did not have access to an internet enabled device due to the delay in receiving these from the DFE scheme. Unfortunately, the school was not able to order our allocated devices until the Monday we declared that a group was self-isolating. These devices have now arrived and will be issued as soon as possible. These devices will now be available for any future periods of isolation for other students.

All year 7 students will return fully on Tuesday 17th November. They will be completing assessments in all subjects from Tuesday 17th November until Monday 23rd November as their Assessment Week was postponed. An outline of what they will be assessed on in each subject is available on the school website for your information.

Thank you for your ongoing patience and support. I hope that yourself and your child have stayed well and managed as well as possible during this period.
