Re: Paris – Wednesday, 5th July to Saturday, 8th July 2023

We are arranging a trip to Paris, the capital city of France from Wednesday, 5th July to Saturday, 8th July 2023. The trip will include:

- Travel insurance
- The use of an executive coach throughout the trip
- Return Eurotunnel Channel Crossing
- Accommodation in a student-friendly accommodation on a full-board basis.
- Various activities during the trip, which include - Visit to Disneyland Paris (1 Day, 2 Park Ticket), Boat Cruise on River Seine, visit to Montmartre area, Guided tour of Stade de France, visit to Louvre Museum, visit to Musée d'Orsay, visit to Sacre Coeur and visit to the Eiffel Tower

There are at least 30 places available and the cost for this trip will be £600 provided that all 30 places are filled. In order to register your interest and secure a place on this trip, we are asking for an initial non-returnable payment of £80 in order to secure accommodation at the best possible price. The remaining balance can be paid in 4 parts or all at once. Therefore, the payment schedule is as follows:

- £80 by Wednesday 30th October 2022 (non-returnable)
- £130 by Wednesday 30th November 2022
- £130 by Tuesday 31st January 2023
- £130 by Tuesday 28th February 2023
- £130 by Friday 31st March 2023

This should be paid online. Students will need a valid passport to travel and a copy will need to be handed to Mr McCracken by Friday 31st March 2023. Please note that passport renewals can take up to 6 weeks. Please also note that the total cost is based on current prices and quotes collected – this may increase should these prices increase significantly.

We appreciate that trips like this can be expensive for families, if you are in receipt of free school meals or your circumstances have changed recently, please do contact Mrs Rust by e mail on admin@lealands.luton.sch.uk or ask to speak to her through reception, for a confidential conversation and to see if we can support you in any way.

We would also like to emphasise that acceptance onto this trip is subject to behaviour and attitude to learning. Any student whose behaviour or conduct in school presents a concern to staff will not be allowed to be part of this trip and may not be refunded any money already paid.

Further information will be provided once deposits have been secured and parents will be invited in for a meeting closer to the time.
