Please can I remind all parents of the importance of students arriving to school fully equipped and in full correct uniform. For students who wear a head scarf, this should conform to our uniform policy and the school tie must remain visible. Shoes should be plain black, leather type shoes (more details and examples are available to support parents on our website). Trousers are required to be tailored and must not be over tight and leggings are not permitted. Skirts must be of the appropriate length. Whilst we aim to keep costs low with minimal standard branded items, we recognise the financial hardship that many families are facing. Should you have any difficulties with providing uniform items for your child, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's Pastoral Support Manager who will be able to assist. Staff have been busy this week, preparing for students to return and are very much looking forward to welcoming everyone back on Monday.
