The Behaviour Ladder - The 3 Cs.

Stage 1 - You know the rules but do not get them right.

You get your warning - Your **CHANCE** to change.

Stage 2 - You did not take your chance so need to leave the room for a few minutes. You now need to make the right **CHOICE** to follow expectations for the rest of the lesson.

Stage 3 - You did not make the right choice in Stage 2 so the **CONSEQUENCE** is inevitable - Removed to reflection for the rest of the lesson and meet teacher in detention at the end of day.

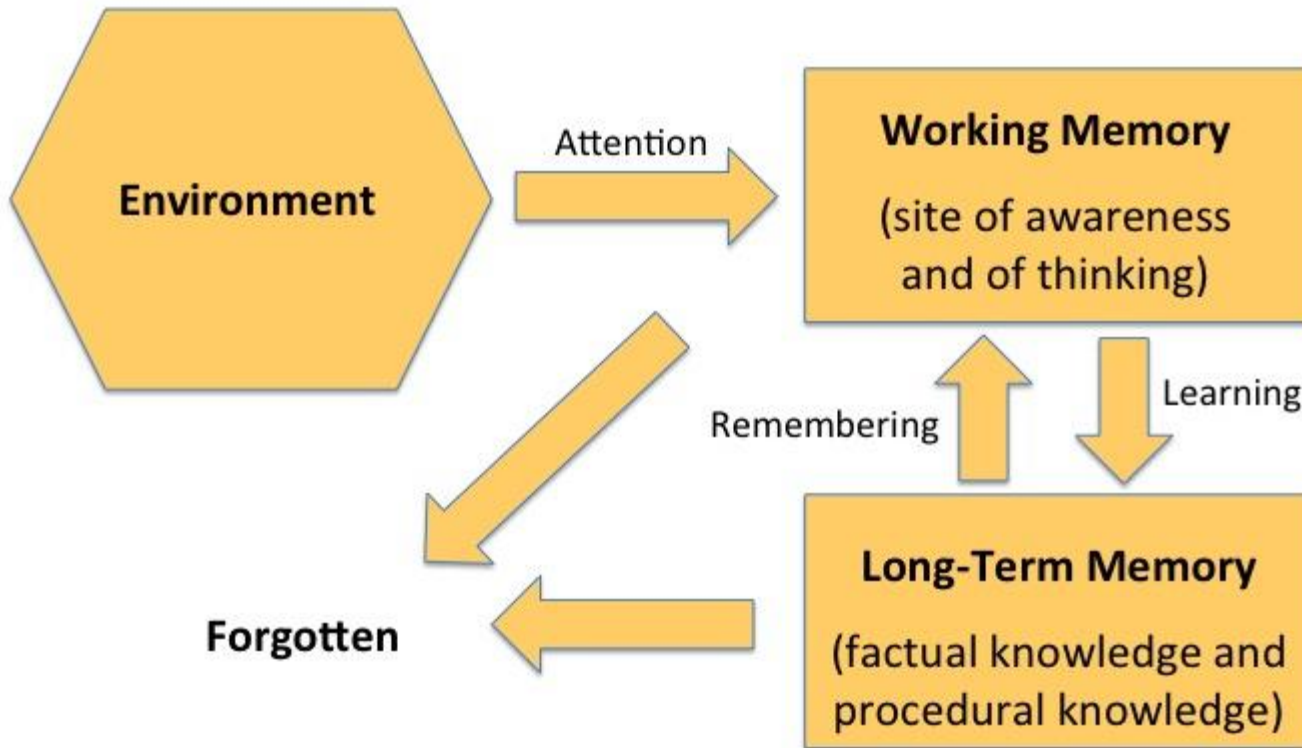

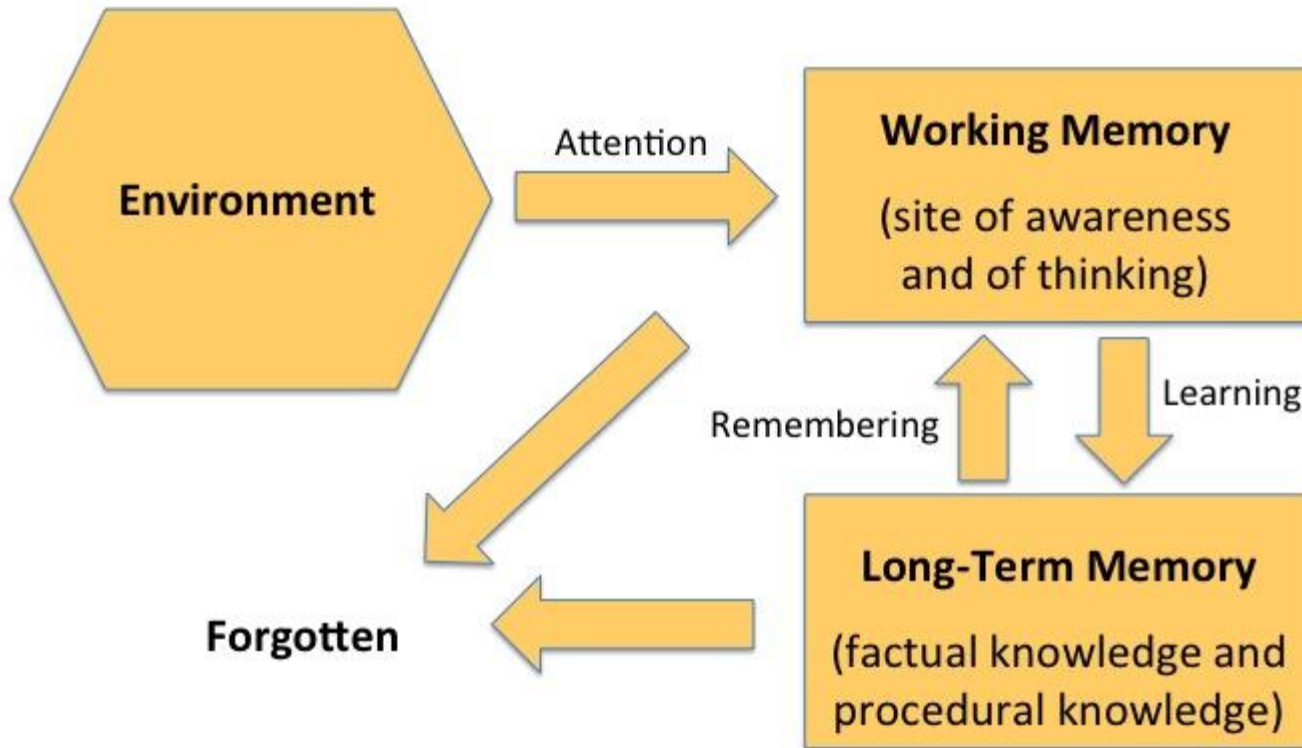
