Hoodies and Sweatshirts

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Students are not meant to bring hoodies or sweatshirts into school and instead, should be wearing coats. However, the line between coats and hoodies can be blurred so I have tried to distinguish between them with some pictures.

Hoodies can be zip up or over the head and often but not always have sports logos on them. Some students wear these under their blazers instead of jumpers.

If students are wearing these or any garments under blazers as alternative jumpers, they would not be classed as an outside coat. Hoodies are made of thin sweatshirt material and are often used by students instead of jumpers, under their blazers.

The only item that should be worn under a blazer is a school jumper.









Fleece jackets

Many students wear a fleecy jacket as a coat. These would not be classed as a hoody/sweatshirt.
