**Lealands Transition Summer School - Mon 26<sup>th</sup> July to Fri 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021 (9am-4pm)**

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to inform you that your child qualifies for a fully funded place at this year's Summer School. In addition to the summer school, we will be offering continued support with Reading and maths through our online programmes of Readingwise and Hegarty Maths.

This year we are offering an incentive scheme to encourage participation. If your child attends and engages well on all 5 days of the summer school and completes an additional 15 hours in both reading and maths through our online programmes, they will be able to earn a further discount of up to £50 towards the cost of a Chromebook through the school's scheme, a fully stocked pencil case – including a scientific calculator, an art pack and an online log into Luton libraries. **The Chromebook discount will be confirmed early in September.**

The aim of the programme is to provide a blend of academic education and enrichment activities. This dual focus will support pupils' academic progress and their social and emotional needs, which will enable them to enjoy new experiences, build confidence, reinforce learning and reinforce positive patterns of behaviour. Following a difficult couple of years in education, we think this is an excellent opportunity to ensure your child makes a flying start to their secondary education in September.

During the course of the week, your child will have the opportunity to participate in numerous fun and exciting activities. They will be able to access all of our fantastic PE facilities, including our swimming pool. They will also benefit from a structured literacy and numeracy programme, which we believe will help them best access their new secondary curriculum.

Some of the activities we have delivered in the past include; designing, constructing and launching rockets, generally making things go 'Bang!' with Science, teambuilding challenges, super-soaker water fights, treasure hunts, Crime Scene Investigation (CSI) and circus skills.

All activities will take place here at Lealands and will be delivered or supervised by our own staff. We believe this is a great opportunity for your child to benefit from excellent teaching and coaching, which will help them develop their skills and aid their transition to high school.

All participants will also be provided with a picnic lunch, although they can bring their own packed lunch if they prefer. They will not be allowed to leave the school site during breaks to buy lunch.
